SUPPLEMENTAL NO. 1 TO PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES CONTRACT FOR PYLE AVENUE – LAS VEGAS BOULEVARD TO BERMUDA ROAD STARR AVENUE – LAS VEGAS BOULEVARD TO BERMUDA ROAD

THIS Supplemental No. 1 Contract, made and entered into this 3rday of 2022, between CLARK COUNTY, NEVADA, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY", and POGGEMEYER DESIGN GROUP, INC., a corporation authorized to do business under the laws of the State of Nevada, hereinafter referred to as "ENGINEER".

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, on August 3, 2021, the COUNTY and the ENGINEER entered into a contract for professional engineering services for design services for Pyle Avenue – Las Vegas Boulevard to Bermuda Road and Starr Avenue – Las Vegas Boulevard to Bermuda Road; and,

WHEREAS, the COUNTY desires to pursue additional professional engineering services to provide additional design services related to the increased scope on the traffic signal modifications portion of the Project; and,

WHEREAS, the ENGINEER desires to provide such services in exchange for the fees hereinafter specified; and,

WHEREAS, Supplemental No. 1 adds \$177,654.90 increasing the total contract value to \$1,137,676.20.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants herein contained, it is agreed as follows:

ARTICLE I: DEFINITIONS

Add the following to the definition of "Project":

The design work related to the Traffic Signal modifications within the existing project limits has been expanded to include:

PYLE AVENUE/POLLOCK DRIVE TRAFFIC SIGNAL

- Survey (right-of-way/easement, roadway grades, ADA Ramps, pullbox locations and types, poles, all other Signal equipment). 500 feet of survey needed in each direction from the intersection. Flown topo and aerial image by sub-consultant.
- 2. Design modification to existing signal infrastructure.
- 3. Existing signal infrastructure mapping.
- 4. Provide Special Provisions and Cost Estimate.
- 5. Design ADA ramp locations to satisfy PROWAG requirements.
- 6. Design and revisions to underground pull boxes as needed based on existing conduit plan.
- 7. Install all required Signal equipment needed.
- 8. Design Phasing for intersection.
- 9. Possible Easement needed to install Signal Poles along Pyle Avenue Eastbound Side pending on location of Ex ROW to satisfy PROWAG requirements for sidewalk clearances.
- 10. Traffic Striping updates.
- 11. Install illuminated Street Name signs.
- 12. Design and location of Ped push button installation.
- 13. Install loop detectors and Camera Actuators for Signal.
- 14. Replacing 2 streetlight poles along Eastbound Pyle Avenue with Signal Poles for Eastbound Pyle traffic movement and Pollock Travel Movement.
- 15. Mill and overlay intersection for loop installation.
- 16. Replace Existing Signal poles with new standard dual Luminaire poles.
- 17. Coordinate with RTC on any Fast installation needs (Fiber/CCTV).
- 18. Pothole existing utilities as needed.

STARR AVENUE/DEAN MARTIN DRIVE TRAFFIC SIGNAL

- 1. Survey (right-of-way/easement, roadway grades, ADA ramps, pullbox locations and types, poles, signal equipment). 500 feet of survey needed in each direction from the intersection. Flown topo and aerial image by sub-consultant.
- 2. Design modification to the existing signal infrastructure. Coordination with Clark County Public Works.
- 3. Provide Special Provisions and Cost Estimate.
- 4. Design ADA ramp locations to satisfy PROWAG requirements.
- 5. Design and revisions to underground pull boxes as needed based on existing conduit plan.
- 6. Existing signal infrastructure mapping.
- 7. Install all required signal equipment needed.
- 8. Design phasing for the intersection.
- 9. Traffic striping updates.
- 10. Install illuminated street name signs.
- 11. Design and determine location of pedestrian push button installation.
- 12. Install loop detectors and camera actuators for signal.
- 13. Mill and overlay existing pavement within intersection limits for installation of loops.
- 14. Provide special provisions and a cost estimate for signal installation.
- 15. Coordinate with RTC on any FAST installation needs (Fiber/CCTV).
- 16. Pothole existing utilities as needed.

ARTICLE V: PAYMENT FOR SERVICES

5.01 Maximum Amount Payable

Delete the first paragraph in this Section and replace with the following:

The maximum amount payable by the COUNTY to the ENGINEER shall be a sum of money equal to the Basic Services fees plus the Special Service fees, if, as, and when approved by the Director, and provided, however, that under no circumstances may the total amount payable to the ENGINEER under this Contract or in connection with the subject matter of this Contract, exceed the sum of Nine Hundred Eighty-One Thousand One Hundred Seventy-One and 30/100 Dollars (\$981,171.30) for the Basic Service fees, and One Hundred Fifty-Six Thousand Five Hundred Four and 90/100 Dollars (\$156,504.90) for Special Services fees, unless such sum is increased by the Clark County Board of Commissioners, but only to the extent such total sum is increased.

5.02 Basic Services and Special Services Fees

Delete the last paragraph in this Section and replace with the following:

In no event may the fees exceed the following Basic Services and the Special Services fees shown below in purposes or amounts:
