**RESOLUTION
OF THE CLARK COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CLARK COUNTY MASTER PLAN -
NORTHEAST LAS VEGAS VALLEY TRANSPORTATION MAP**

WHEREAS, the Clark County Board of Commissioners (hereafter referred to as the Board) may adopt long-term master plans for the physical development of all unincorporated portions of the Clark County, Nevada as specified by the Nevada Revised Statutes, Chapter 278; and

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2022, the Clark County Planning Commission (hereafter referred to as the Planning Commission) did adopt an amendment to the Northeast Las Vegas Valley Transportation Map of the Clark County Master Plan and forwarded a copy to the Board for consideration, and:

WHEREAS, on June 22, 2022, a public hearing was held by the Board in accordance with Nevada Revised Statute 278.220 regarding the Clark County Master Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board does adopt and amend the Clark County Northeast Las Vegas Valley Transportation Map by:

1. PA-22-700002 - Amending Northeast Las Vegas Valley Transportation Map of the Clark County Master Plan by reducing the right-of-way width from 100 feet to 80 feet for Hollywood Boulevard between Alto Avenue and Lake Mead Boulevard.
