

**SUPPLEMENTAL NO. 2 TO THE
PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES CONTRACT
FOR JONES BOULEVARD BLUE DIAMOND ROAD TO WINDMILL LANE**

THIS Supplemental No. 2 Contract, made and entered into this 21st day of June, 2022, between Clark County, Nevada, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, and R2H Engineering, Inc. d/b/a Horrocks Engineers, Inc., a corporation authorized to do business under the laws of the State of Nevada, hereinafter referred to as ENGINEER. The COUNTY and ENGINEER may herein be referred individually as “Party” or collectively as “Parties”.

WHEREAS, on August 2, 2016, the COUNTY and the ENGINEER entered into a contract for professional engineering services for design services for Jones Boulevard, Blue Diamond Road to Windmill Lane and,

WHEREAS, on December 21, 2021, the COUNTY and the ENGINEER entered into Supplemental No. 1 to the Contract to extend the time of performance due to delays caused by the acquisition of right of way and,

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2022, the COUNTY, R2H Engineering, Inc., R2H Engineering, Inc. d/b/a Horrocks Engineers, Inc., and Horrocks Engineers, Inc. entered into an Assignment Agreement to assign the contracts from R2H Engineering, Inc. to R2H Engineering, Inc. d/b/a Horrocks Engineers, Inc. and,

WHEREAS, the design requires updates because of delays due to right-of-way acquisitions along Jones Boulevard and the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) agreement, and the COUNTY desires the ENGINEER to perform additional professional engineering design services in an amount not to exceed \$160,000.00 in Special Services in order to complete the final plans and specifications for the Project, and,

WHEREAS, the ENGINEER desires to provide such services in exchange for the fees hereinafter specified; and,

WHEREAS, this Supplemental No. 2 increases funding by \$160,000.00 and brings the total contract amount to \$1,390,404.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants herein contained, it is agreed to supplement the professional engineering service contract dated August 2, 2016, and Supplemental No. 1 to the Contract dated December 21, 2021, as follows:

ARTICLE II: SCOPE OF SERVICES

2.03 Special Services, add the following paragraph:

- M. Provide additional design, including a feasibility analysis for an off-set intersection, additional traffic striping, plan updates due to design code updates, waterline relocation redesign, additional private development coordination, and related services in the event the Director finds it necessary to perform additional work not specified in Section 2.02, but required for and related to the Project.
- N. Coordinate with Clark County Water Reclamation District (CCWRD) to include CCWRD plans and special provisions for the Collection System Capacity Upgrade – Package 2 (Project No. 18101A) into the Jones Boulevard, Blue Diamond Road to Windmill Lane project for advertising and construction.

ARTICLE V: PAYMENT FOR SERVICES

5.01 Maximum Amount Payable

The first paragraph in this section shall be changed to read as follows:

The maximum amount payable by the COUNTY to the ENGINEER shall be a sum of money equal to the Basic Services fees, plus the Special Services fees, if, as, and when approved by the Director, and provided, however, that under no circumstances may the total amount payable to the ENGINEER under this Contract or in connection with the subject matter of this Contract, exceed the sum of Nine Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Nine and 00/100 Dollars (\$985,129.00) for the Basic Services fees, and up to Four Hundred Five Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-Five and 00/100 Dollars (\$405,275.00) for Special Services fees, unless such sum is increased by the Clark County Board of Commissioners, but only to the extent such total sum is increased.

5.02 Basic Services and Special Services Fees

The fees shall be changed to read as follows:

The remainder of the Professional Engineering Services Contract dated August 2, 2016, and Supplement No. 1 to the Contract dated December 21, 2021, remains unchanged.
