Ratify and approve an amendment for the acceptance of the subaward Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity (ELC) grant from the State of Nevada, Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), Division of Public and Behavioral Health to provide services and efforts to detect and mitigate the proliferation of coronavirus in confinement facilities, amongst staff and juveniles; and authorize the Director or his designee to sign any additional grant documents as related thereto. BACKGROUND:

Clark County Department of Juvenile Justice Services (DJJS) has solicited funding from the State of Nevada DHHS to provide services that would assist with detection and mitigation efforts related to COVID-19 in Juvenile Detention and Spring Mountain Youth Camp (SMYC) divisions at DJJS.

This grant funding enables DJJS to enhance communication and technology systems within Detention and SMYC, and ensure youth residing in these facilities engage with their families, extended support systems, and other system partners while limiting exposure and following safe practices for the prevention of spreading COVID-19. These funds would also be utilized for personal protective equipment (PPE) and deep cleaning services.

This grant was originally approved by the Board of County Commissioners on February 1, 2022. On July 1, 2022, the State of Nevada made the following adjustments:

1. Adjusted the original award amount of \$796,220, increasing it to \$861,220.
2. Added language to Goal 2 of the grant - it now states to "provide deep cleaning services within the confinement facility."
3. Allowed \$165,000 to be transferred from the "Other" grant category to the "Equipment" grant category.

The State has made the grant award contingent upon the submission of a signed Notice of Subaward (NOSA). DJJS requests the Board ratify and accept the submittal of the NOSA and accept any funds awarded.
