## **BACKGROUND:**

On April 7, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approved the award of CBE No. 605596-20 to United States Geological Survey (LBE) in the amount of \$141,678 for investigating the reproductive ecology and development of successful propagation techniques for 5 of Clark County's rare plant species, so that nursery stock can eventually be established and utilized for conservation purposes.

The following are the pertinent provisions of the Contract:

- The term of the Contract was from date of award through May 4, 2022.
- Included the County's option to terminate for cause, convenience or default and suspend the Contract with advanced written notice.
