BACKGROUND:

Chapter 501.260 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) establishes a County Advisory Board to Manage Wildlife consisting of five or seven members. The Clark County Advisory Board to Manage Wildlife (CCABMW) of seven members serves in an advisory capacity to the Nevada State Board of Wildlife Commissioners by soliciting and evaluating local opinion on matters relating to the management of wildlife in Clark County and the state of Nevada. Pursuant to NRS 501.265–501.275, the Board of County Commissioners appoints qualified persons to the CCABMW who are residents of the county.

With the expiration of Daniel Gilbert’s term, there is one vacancy on the CCABMW for a person who is: (1) a resident of Clark County; and (2) a hunter, trapper, angler, or engaged in ranching or farming. Two qualified persons applied for the opening after it was advertised in the "Las Vegas Review-Journal" and posted on the County website and at the Department of Environment and Sustainability between June 15 and July 15, 2022: Daniel Gilbert and Dr. Jason Lamarr Wasden.
