## Welcome Home Community Housing Fund (CHF)

#### Created April 2022

### For housing related programs

- Construction of multifamily rental projects
- Affordable homeownership
- County land

Housing Needs & Affordability Critical Shortage of Housing for Low Income Households in Southern Nevada

### Area Median Income (AMI)

- 30% of AMI: \$17,000 \$24,500/yr
- 50/60% AMI: \$28,000 \$49,000/yr
- 80% AMI: \$45,000 \$65,00/yr

## Current CHF Funding Round

- To support the development of affordable rental housing
- Application opened May 2022
- Closed June 13th
- Over 50 Pre-Applications submitted, totaling \$360,582,000
- 39 Applications advanced to final scoring, totaling \$281,847,000



# Application Review & Scoring

- <u>Pre-Application</u> Reviewed applications for completeness and meeting threshold requirements
- Scoring Process
  - Community Panel Review Community members with construction and development, affordable housing, and social services backgrounds
  - Underwriting Review Third party evaluation by a firm with affordable housing finance and underwriting expertise
  - Social Service and Community Housing Team Review
- Internal Panel Scores above 50 were recommended for awards; recommended award amounts based on need and leverage of CHF dollars
