I have many years of experience with public administration. In addition to my years with the City of Las Vegas, I also was a commissioner's attorney at the Public Service Commission in Clark County and clerked for the Honorable Earle White, Jr. in Clark County. Furthermore, I have been a Clark County Air Pollution Control Hearing Officer since 2016.

I enjoy participation in hearings of all types, including Air Pollution Control Hearings. As a hearing officer, I have the ability to affect the efficiency of the hearing including the outpouring of information, the receipt of factual evidence, and the testimony of witnesses.
