BACKGROUND:

Following the onset of COVID-19 and the receipt of federal grant funds, the County engaged the community to determine the impacts of the pandemic as well as the immediate and long-term recovery needs. The engagement process included community meetings, a grant application site, and interviews with a variety of community stakeholders and local government representatives.

Clark County Water Reclamation District submitted an application for the Septic System Conversion Pilot Program, in partnership with the Southern Nevada Health District and Southern Nevada Water Authority. The program objectives include allowing home and business owners to convert and connect to the sewer line if it is within four hundred (400) feet of their property. This septic conversion will allow for wastewater to be recovered, treated, and returned to Lake Mead. This treatment flow cycle will result in additional return flow credits and will protect water quality to the groundwater systems the septic systems are impacting.

At the Board of County Commissioners Meeting on August 16, 2022, an amount of \$15,000,000 was approved for use by the Clark County Water Reclamation District. Pursuant to NRS 244.1505, the County Manager or his designee has executed the required interlocal agreement with Clark County Water Reclamation District, the governmental entity applicant.

Staff recommends approval of the interlocal agreement between Clark County and Clark County Water Reclamation District.
