Additional Comments:	Initial contract amount was \$1,000,000 and Supplemental Nos. 1 and 2 combined amounts increased contract by \$1,600,000. Supplemental No. 3 increase of \$600,000 revises the total contract value to \$3,200,000.		

## **BACKGROUND:**

On August 9, 2018, the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) and Clark County entered into Interlocal Contract No. 1026 for the Fort Apache Road between Blue Diamond Road and Warm Springs Road project providing funds for engineering on its annual Capital Improvements Program from Fuel Revenue Indexing Funds. The Board of County Commissioners approved this contract on September 4, 2018.

RTC and the Board subsequently approved two supplementals to Interlocal Contract No. 1026 to increase funds for engineering and right-of-way costs.

The attached Supplemental No. 3 to Interlocal Contract 1026 increases funds for additional right-of-way. The time of performance remains effective to June 30, 2023, unless time extensions are granted.

RTC approved the third supplemental contract at its meeting on April 13, 2023.

The District Attorney's Office has reviewed and approved the third supplemental contract as to form.
