## **BACKGROUND:**

The Moapa Valley Fire Protection District is eligible for grant funding through the Federal Emergency Management Agency. The grant application is characterized as the Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response "SAFER" Program and improves or restores local fire departments' staffing and deployment capabilities so they may more effectively respond to emergencies. The grant does not require any match and does not require a continuation of employment covered by the grant at the end of the performance period under the grant.

If approved, the grant will be used to purchase PPE and provide volunteer stipends. Additionally, the grant will fund one (1) part time recruitment and retention coordinator to manage volunteers and conduct onboarding and trainings. This grant does not have a requirement for the Moapa Valley Fire Protection District to continue to fund the position at the end of the performance period of the grant.

If awarded, this grant will provide funding to help with recruitment and retention of volunteers and provide a higher level of service to the greater Moapa Valley Area.
