



In 2023, RDS licensed 21 more Foster Care Regular homes than we closed.


Overall, there are 42 more homes at the end of 2023 than at the start.








HOUSEHOLD:Preservice






Top Referral Sources




Licensing Rate Rising







Streamlined Licensing Timeline




Licensing by #of Beds







Kinship Files Assigned to FST's

Kinship Stabilization



Disruptions



The QPI Coordinator continues to work with teams across Family Services to ensure families have what they need to care for children, so that children do not disrupt. The disruption rate is an average of 52 children per month- the lowest is has been since 2020.

WRAPS Team



WRAPS Team was launched June 2023, this team was developed to be an ongoing resource to wrap placement supports with necessary resources and sustain healthy relationships while addressing any potential barriers with placements and minimize disruptions.

Resources include intervention services, referrals, wraparound services, transportation support, respite information, advocacy, conflict management, supportive services and guidance.

In addition to making support calls and visits, WRAPS completed 10 special projects including a Coat Drive with Senator Dina Neal and Crisis Support with Las Vegas Metro Police Department.
