BACKGROUND:

The CARES Act established the Coronavirus Relief Fund (the "Fund") and appropriated \$150 billion to the Fund for assistance to state and local governments. On April 23, 2020, Clark County was allocated \$295 million in CRF Funds available under section 601(a) of the Social Security Act, as added by section 5001 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act"). On December 21, 2020, Congress passed the Consolidated Appropriations Act 2021 providing additional coronavirus emergency response and relief funds to state and local governments.
