**THIS AMENDMENT** is made and entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 2021, by and between CLARK COUNTY, NEVADA (hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY"), and BOARD OF REGENTS, NEVADA SYSTEM OF HIGHER EDUCATION ON BEHALF OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NEVADA, LAS VEGAS (hereinafter referred to as "UNLV").

**WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS**, the parties entered into an agreement under CBE Number 605224-19, entitled "Interlocal Agreement" dated June 18, 2019 (hereinafter referred to as AGREEMENT); and

**WHEREAS**, the parties desire to amend the AGREEMENT.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the parties agree to amend the AGREEMENT as follows:

1. Scope of Work, Page 5, Subsection 6. Principal Investigator.

**Principal Investigator:** Emily Salisbury, Ph.D. will be the research partner and evaluator. She will be involved in the planning and implementation phase as an "active researcher" and will be conducting the systematic implementation mapping during the planning phase. Dr. Salisbury will also be responsible for compiling the performance measures, data collection, instrumentation development, report writing, and technical assistance. She will oversee the validation studies of the WRNA.

**Year 2** includes a two-course buyout for the 2020 calendar year, one for each semester plus 5.87% summer salary

**Facilities and administrative (F&A):** Costs are infrastructure and administration costs associated with the conduct of research and other sponsored projects that cannot be readily and specifically identified with a particular project. F&A costs are synonymous with "indirect costs" and "overhead" and are incurred for expenses such as utilities; buildings; operation and maintenance; library-related expenditures; university services, such as telephones and computer infrastructure; department, college, and service unit administrative costs; and federally mandated research compliance.

Predetermined federal F&A rates are established for UNLV with the Department of Health and Human Services/Department of Cost Allocations, which operates as UNLV's cognizant agency for the federal government.
