AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CLARK COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 3.72 TO UPDATE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF CLARK, STATE OF NEVADA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. 3.72.020 of the Clark County Code is amended to read as follows: 3.72.020 - Created—Membership generally.

There is created the local law enforcement advisory committee. The members of the committee shall be appointed annually by the board and shall consist of [the district attorney; the sheriff; a local judge; a representative of the Clark County school district; a representative of a local nonprofit, educational, religious, or community group active in crime prevention or drug use prevention or treatment; a member of the Las Vegas city council; two members of the board; and such other members with recognized interests in criminal justice, crime prevention, or substance abuse prevention and treatment as are

determined appropriate by the board] two (2) members of the Las Vegas City Council and three (3) members of the Board of County Commissioners. The board shall appoint a chair and vice-chair from among the members of the board appointed to the committee.

SECTION TWO. If any section of this ordinance or portion thereof is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate the remaining parts of this ordinance.

SECTION THREE: All ordinances, parts of ordinances, chapters, sections, subsections, clauses, phrases, or sentences contained in the Clark County Code in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION FOUR: This ordinance shall be published thereof by title only, together with the names of the County Commissioners voting for or against its passage, in a newspaper published in and having general circulation in Clark County, Nevada, at least once a week for a period of two (2) weeks, and shall be effective on and from the fifteenth day after passage and thereafter until _______, 2021, unless extended by official action of the Board.
