# SUPPLEMENTAL NO. 3 TO THE PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES CONTRACT FOR RUSSELL ROAD - PARADISE ROAD TO MOUNTAIN VISTA STREET, AND EASTERN AVENUE - TOMPKINS AVENUE TO SUNSET ROAD PAVEMENT REHABILITATION

THIS SUPPLEMENTAL CONTRACT, made and entered into this day of the State of Nevada, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, NEVADA, a political subdivision of authorized to do business under the laws of the State of Nevada, hereinafter referred to as ENGINEER.

#### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, on February 19, 2019 the COUNTY and the ENGINEER entered into a Professional Engineering Services Contract for Russell Road, Paradise Road to Mountain Vista Street, and Eastern Avenue, Tompkins Avenue to Sunset Road; and

WHEREAS, on October 2, 2019, the COUNTY and the ENGINEER entered into Supplemental No. 1 to extend the duration of the Contract; and,

WHEREAS, on July 21, 2020, the COUNTY and the ENGINEER entered into Supplemental No. 2 to perform additional engineering services and extend the duration of the Contract; and,

WHEREAS, the COUNTY requested that the ENGINEER increase engineering services and associated post design services to include additional engineering calculations, investigations, traffic signal modification, utility and agency coordination, and additional survey services; and

WHEREAS, this supplemental contract increases funding by \$70,000.00 giving a total contract amount of \$831,014.00.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants herein contained, the parties mutually agree to supplement the Professional Engineering Services Contract dated February 19, 2019 and Supplemental No. 1 dated October 2, 2019 and Supplemental No. 2 dated July 21, 2020 as follows:

#### ARTICLE II: SCOPE OF SERVICES

#### 2.03 Special Services

Replace 2.03A as follows:

A. Provide additional design and related services in the event the Director finds it necessary to perform additional work not specified in Sections 2.02, but required for and related to the Project.

The ENGINEER is authorized to perform the additional work as follows:

Investigate options for a barrier rail to be installed adjacent to an existing flood control channel located on the south side of Russell Road between Euclid Street and Topaz Street. Meet with Clark County Maintenance to discuss issues and potential maintenance access. Evaluate traffic engineering criteria and recommend whether to install a barrier rail, or whether a change the existing roadway striping to add a right turn only to the west of Euclid Street would eliminate the need for a new barrier rail.

Perform additional coordination and update plans and special provisions for adding traffic signal modifications at Eastern Avenue and Sunset Road. Additional work includes adding signal loops and extending milling and Ultra-Thin Asphalt Concrete Surface (UTACS) within Sunset Road at Eastern Avenue, as well as additional utility research, investigating sidewalk ramps and signal appurtenances for compliance with current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) criteria, and updating the encroachment permit with the Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT).

For simplifying stationing adjustments during construction, update the centerline control for Russell Road to match field survey obtained by County prior to beginning construction, but after completing the Project design. The alignment for this Project is based off of aerial information rather than a detailed field survey because the design for the roadway resurfacing matches existing roadway asphalt elevations.

Perform survey and prepare a legal description and exhibit for the property located on the northeast corner of Eastern Avenue and Russell Road, APN 162-25-410-008, for dedication of a 54-foot property line radius.

#### ARTICLE V: PAYMENT FOR SERVICES

Revise the first paragraph of 5.01 Maximum Amount Payable as follows:

#### 5.01 Maximum Amount Payable

The maximum amount payable by the COUNTY to the ENGINEER shall be a sum of money equal to the Basic Service fees plus the Special Service fees, if, as, and when approved by the Director, and provided, however, that under no circumstances may the total amount payable to the ENGINEER under this Contract or in connection with the subject matter of this Contract, exceed the sum of Five Hundred Ninety Five Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-Nine and 00/100 Dollars (\$595,589.00) for the Basic Service fees, and Two Hundred Thirty Five Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Five and 00/100 Dollars (\$235,425.00) for Special Services fees, unless such sum is increased by the Clark County Board of Commissioners, but only to the extent such total sum is increased.

Revise the last paragraph of 5.02 Basic Services and Special Services Fees as follows:

#### 5.02 Basic Services and Special Services Fees

In no event may the fees exceed the following Basic Services and the Special Services fees shown below in purposes or amounts:

The remainder of the Professional Engineering Services Contract dated February 19, 2019 and Supplemental No. 1 dated October 2, 2019 and Supplemental No. 2 dated July 21, 2020 remains unchanged.
