## **BACKGROUND:**

On July 19, 2016, the Board of County Commissioners approved a professional engineering services contract with GCW, Inc. to provide engineering services for roadway improvements for one or more roadways identified within the latest Capital Improvement Program adopted by the Board and for the rehabilitation of existing public roadways within the County.

The Board approved Supplemental Nos. 1 and 2 with GCW, Inc. for additional engineering services on January 2, 2018 and July 16, 2019, respectively.

The attached Supplemental No. 3 to the professional engineering services contract with GCW, Inc. will increase total funds for additional design and construction support services for work order projects and updates some of the language in the original contract. GCW, Inc. currently holds a Clark County Business License.
