Additional Comments:	The initial Contract amount was \$5,251,243. Amendment No. 1 will increase the Contract amount by \$760,988.32, for a new total Contract amount of \$6,012,231.32.		

**BACKGROUND:**

On July 26, 2016, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approved the award of RFP No. 603986-16 to Correct Care Solutions, LLC (LBE) in the amount of \$1,003,632 annually for medical services for Department of Juvenile Justice Services.

On July 14, 2021, the Department of Administrative Services processed a name change from Correct Care Solutions, LLC to Wellpath, LLC.

The following are the pertinent provisions of the Contract:

- The term of the Contract was from August 1, 2016 through July 31, 2017 and included the option to renew for 4, one-year periods. There are no renewal options remaining.
- Included the County's option to terminate for cause, convenience or default and suspend the Contract with advanced written notice.

Approval of Amendment No. 1 will extend the Contract term through March 31, 2022 and will modify the Staffing Matrices to increase shift hours. The attached Amendment No. 1 document details the modifications and costs involved.
