Clients admitted to subsequent steps of the PROGRAM continuum (i.e., Transitional Housing and Permanent Supportive Housing) must originate in the program via the Crisis Stabilization phase.

ADD:

Benefits Establishment: assessing the financial status of clients, identifying benefits to which clients may be entitled (Medicare, Medicaid) and performing all actions including advocacy to ensure entitlements are established.

5. EXHIBIT A, PAGE A-5, 6. RESPONSIBILITIES OF PROVIDER

ADD:

PROVIDER must utilize all existing insurance sources, such as, but not limited to, Medicare, Medicaid, and/or any other insurance providers BEFORE requesting expenses to be paid by Clark County Social Service. PROVIDER will complete their due diligence to verify insurance coverages prior to billing COUNTY for any services provided and performed.
